



VISITATION GUIDE

Arranging a Visit

- Visiting is by appointment only by calling (814) 587-2012.
- Visiting Hours are Monday- Sunday (9:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M.)
- Visits will be scheduled in 30 minute time blocks and must be scheduled in advance.
- Visits are limited to two visitors per resident as a means to maintain the core principles of infection prevention. (Exceptions made on case by case situation)
- Visits will be monitored by staff.
- Visitors will be screened for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 upon arrival. If they fail the screening, the visit will be rescheduled.
- Visitors must notify Rolling Fields, if they develop COVID-19 symptoms within two days of their visit.
- Visitation areas will be cleaned and sanitized between visits.

Outdoor Visitation

Outdoor visitation is preferred, even when resident and visitor are fully vaccinated* against COVID-19. Outdoor visits generally pose a lower risk of transmission due to increased space and airflow. Therefore, visits should be held outdoors whenever practicable.

Indoor Visitation

- Indoor visitation may be limited or suspended depending upon the active case status in the community or facility.
- Indoor visitation will occur in common areas that limit visitor movement through resident care areas.
- In-room visits can be arranged under limited circumstances at the discretion of the administrator or IP designee.

Visitation Expectations

- Social distancing of minimum of six feet is required.
- Gifts and personal items can be exchanged at visit.
- Masks/face coverings or other required PPE must be worn throughout the entire visit.
- Masks must cover the nose and mouth at all times.
- Eating or drinking is not allowed during the visit.
- Hand sanitizing and/or hygiene should be done upon arrival and upon end of the visit.
- If the resident is fully vaccinated*, they can choose to have brief close contact (including touch) with their visitor while wearing a well-fitted face mask and performing hand-hygiene before and after.
- Visitors who are unable to adhere to the core principles of COVID-19 infection prevention should not be permitted to visit or should be asked to leave.

EXCEPTIONS

Newly admitted unvaccinated elders will not be eligible for visits until 14 days have passed since date of admission.

Any elder who is positive or suspected for COVID-19 will be ineligible for a visit until off quarantine.

**Fully vaccinated: More than 14 days has passed since the receipt of the second dose of a 2 dose vaccine or single dose of a one dose vaccine.*
